

PARTNERING WITH AMREF HEALTH AFRICA TO INTEGRATE NUTRITION INTO PUBLIC HEALTH PROGRAMS

Missed opportunity

Amref Health Africa reaches more than 10 million vulnerable people across Africa every year with community-based health, water and sanitation, and disease prevention services. Amref Health Africa is a strong advocate for health, but the organization wants to improve how it delivers nutrition service through its existing programs.

Investment

With support from NLIFT, Amref Health Africa will build its capacity to deliver cost-effective nutrition interventions using the organization's existing community health platforms. As part of the partnership, a nutrition technical advisor seconded by Nutrition International to Amref Health Africa will produce a comprehensive nutrition mapping report on its programs, an assessment of staff nutrition knowledge and capacity, and an organizational nutrition strategy. The *Nutrition Integration Strategy* will include actions to integrate nutrition interventions, actions to address any identified capacity gaps, and resource mobilization requirements to support high-impact health and nutrition programs.

Innovation and leverage

This partnership combines Amref Health Africa's community outreach know-how and Nutrition International's nutrition expertise. The partners will use the results of the nutrition mapping to identify areas of collaboration to strengthen nutrition interventions, and to integrate nutrition into all Amref Health Africa's program sectors and countries.
